

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT**

This investigative report pertains to the ongoing case conducted by the Tarpon Springs Police Department concerning the death of Shawn McMillan.

On September 21, 2001 Sgt. MacKenzie submitted various pieces of evidence to the FDLE Crime Lab for examination. One particular item that was submitted to the lab for examination was a Sundance Industries "Laser 25" .25 caliber pistol bearing serial # 088909.

It was requested that this weapon be examined for latent fingerprints that could be used for comparison. Then Latent Fingerprint Section received the weapon and Crime Lab Analyst Steven Stark conducted the examination and determined that there were no latent prints of value. A copy of the lab report will be housed in the related item section of the case file (Related Item #24).
