This report is in reference to a bloodstain pattern analysis that was conducted on November 9, 2001 at the request of Sgt. MacKenzie of the Tarpon Springs Police Department.

EXHIBITS:

- 3 A bloodstained island blue plaid long sleeve shirt
- 4 A pair of bloodstained blue Dungarees jeans
- 6 A left Doc Marten shoe
- 7 A gray bloodstained car windshield sunshade
- 8 A right Doc Marten shoe
- 9 A pair of bloodstained blue Fruit of the Loom men's shorts (boxer underwear)
- 10 A pair of bloodstained gray men's socks

TERMINOLOGY USED IN THIS REPORT:

- CONTACT BLOODSTAIN A bloodstain pattern which resulted from the touching of a bloody object with a non-bloody object.
- IMPACT BLOOD SPATTER A random distribution of small drops of blood which was deposited on an object as a result of a forceful impact.
- SPLASH BLOOD Free-falling blood in excess of one drop which fell or flowed onto an object.
- TARGET The object on which blood was deposited.

EXAMINATION:

Items 6 and 8

No visible bloodstains were observed on these items.

Item 3

The island blue plaid force shirt was a target for contact bloodstains, splashed blood and impact blood spatter.

Item 4

The blue Dungarees jeans was a target for contact bloodstains, dropped and splash blood, and impact blood spatter.

Item 7

The gray car windshield sunshade was a target for impact blood spatter.

Items 9 and 10

The blue Fruit of the Loom men's boxer underwear and the pair of gray socks were targets for contact bloodstains.

CONCLUSION:

The reconstruction of the pertinent impact blood spatter patterns as to their origin, direction of travel and location indicated that the car windshield sunshade and the individual who was wearing the outer clothing (shirt and jeans) were in close proximity to forceful bloodshed.

The dropped and splashed blood resulted from the individual with the gunshot wound issuing blood onto the clothing. The contact bloodstain resulted from the transfer of blood from the bloody clothing to the non-bloody clothing.

A determination as to whether the gunshot wound was or was not self-inflicted could not be made from the items examined.
