- Q. Pub, Rita's car, Steve's car. Does that look about right?
- A. Yes. And my car was right here. We were standing by Steve's car.

So I was sitting in the back of Steve Newman's car with the door open.

Victoria was in the front seat with the door open, and we
were just conversing as to what we were going to do. If we
were going to go home, if we were going to hang out with
everybody or what. And the gun went off. I didn't see who
shot it off. Everybody was saying it was Bernie, but I
didn't see that. I just remember hearing it.

- Q. How did you know they had a gun?
- A. Because I saw it when they were holding it up.
- Q. Okay. When you saw it when they were holding it up, which one of they had it?
- A. Bernie had it. And I remember Rita coming out of the pub. I'm not sure if she had a glass of beer or not. I think she was carrying something. And I remember her saying, "Hey, hey, hey." And she said stuff after that, but I don't remember what she said. I couldn't hear it.
 - Q. Was Shawn standing around that you remember?
 - A. I think Shawn was leaning on the car.
 - Q. When the gun went off?
- A. Leaning against the car with his back towards them they were behind -- they were behind him.

- Q. Do you know where the gun came from?
- A. No. Well, I heard it was Dan's. I knew that Dan had a gun. I'd never seen it.
- Q. That night did you see, do you know who had the gun or anything like that?
 - A. No.
 - Q. You never saw Shawn with the gun?
- A. No. I was pretty surprised to see Shawn there because I didn't think that Shawn hung out with them. And when he was sitting at the game machine when I showed up at the pub, he was sitting by himself at the game machine, and he was kind of like slouched back in the chair, just staring at the game. - A. I saw him maybe five times, four or five times after and that was at the pub.
 - Q. Did he tell you his version of what happened?

- A. Because I guess Steve Newman went to the pub the next day right after it happened and talked to the owner Chris Nordmark. And Steve Newman was like, you know, "I can't believe they would do that when we're all hanging out there."

And somebody said, "Well, Dan got his." And that's when we found out that the gun had went off and that Shawn was dead. And we're still so in shock. So Dan came over at about 2:30 to Victoria's house. And he was just, you know, he was real run down and he was drinking. And just remember him saying. He kept saying over and over again, "The safety was on. The safety

was on."

- Q. Did he give you any other?
- A. He told us that I think he said the gun went off in the car and he jumped -- I think they pulled over, and he jumped in the back seat. And then they rushed up to Helen Ellis because they weren't far from Helen Ellis. And they brought him to Helen Ellis, and he said that they took his shirt because there was blood all over it.
- Q. Did he give you any explanation as to how the gun discharged in the car?
- A. He said that Shawn had it and then he asked for it back. I guess he put his arm back to reach for it and that's when he said it went off.
- Q. Did he indicate he ever got the gun into his hand or anything like that?
 - A. No. I don't think he said he did.
- Q. Did he say he ever bumped the gun or hit him or anything at all that would suggest he had any involvement in the actual discharge of the firearm?
- A. No. He just said that he asked for it back; and when Shawn was passing it back to him, it went off.
- Q. Have you talked with anybody else who is purported to have direct knowledge of what actually happened?
- A. No. Bernie and I were really good friends. We hung out a lot all throughout high school and after high
