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WILLIAM NORDMARK,

the witness herein, being first duly sworn, was examined
and testified as follows:

EXAMINATION

BY MR. BARTLETT:

Q. Mr. Nordmark, would you state your name for the
record please?

A. William Robert Nordmark.

Q. And you're the father of Daniel Nordmark?

A. Correct.

Q. And with regard to the incident that happened on
September 1st rolling over into September 2nd, my
understanding is you have no direct knowledge. You were not
an eyewitness to any part of that incident whatsoever?

A. That's correct.

Q. And became aware of it probably in the early
morning hours or the next Sunday morning?

A. No. Actually we received a call stating that Rita
and Dan were at the hospital and very upset. And we got my
other son Chris, who was Rita's husband; and both, all three
of us went over to the hospital.

Q. Do you recall what time that would have been you
arrived at the hospital?

A. It could have been 3:00. I don't know. It was
the middle of the night.

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1 Q. Were any statements made to you about what
2 happened and if so by whom?

3 A. Both Dan and Rita said that, that Shawn had shot
4 himself in the head, and they were extremely upset,
5 distressed. And they said that he didn't give the gun back
6 to them, or Dan I believe, Dan said he asked for it and he
7 didn't, and he wouldn't give it back to him. And then he
8 just shot himself. Rita said it was this far which is maybe
9 12 inches from her head. She was upset, shaken. Same thing
10 with Dan. He was in tears over the situation. That's about
11 it. Then we just talked and talked and tried to get
12 everybody calmed.

13 Q. Did he indicate any statements were made by Shawn
14 prior to the gun being discharged?

15 A. I don't think so. I don't recall them saying
16 that.

17 Q. Did they say anything about Shawn being
18 intoxicated?

19 A. Yes.

20 Q. Who said what?

21 A. Both of them said he was drunk.

22 Q. How about Dan? Did he appear to be intoxicated?

23 A. Appear to be? Not at that time. He was fairly
24 sober.

25 Q. Okay.

1 A. He was so shaken.

2 Q. Okay. Did you talk to anybody else that night
3 about what actually happened with regard to the incident?

4 A. No.

5 Q. Did anybody say anything about a gun being
6 discharged at the British Pub earlier in the evening?

7 A. No.

8 Q. Let me now direct your attention to the vehicle.
9 At some point in time my understanding is that you became
10 involved in the cleaning of the vehicle?

11 A. Right.

12 Q. After the vehicle had been released?

13 A. Yes. It was the same day in the afternoon.

14 Q. Okay. Tell me about that?

15 A. Rita came over to our house to get some cleaning
16 tools or fluids and wanting to know what would be the best
17 thing to clean the vehicle with. And so we had discussed
18 using Oxyclean I think it was. Because it was such a wonder
19 cleaner. And so Pat got that together, and they both went
20 over to the car. Rita and Pat went down the street because
21 they live about five houses away.

22 I guess they were going to clean, and Pat had
23 given Rita gloves because she's a nurse. And then later on
24 I guess I had come over also to see how they were doing and
25 they were busy cleaning the backseat on the driver's side.
